2. Total points won at current year's rodeo.
3. Qualification (s) to State Finals and National Finals.
4. Applicant's participation in team activities and Longhorn Rodeo production including fund raising and activities.
5. Parent/guardian/family participation in the Longhorn annual Rodeo production, including fund raising activities.
6. Educational goals and ambition after High School.
